## Parade Rules and Regulations:

- You may pass out tracts, flyers, gifts and candy (candy must be handed out from someone walking on the street, it CANNOT be thrown from a moving vehicle!)
- You may play music on your float (please be respectful to other floats and participants)
- Animals are welcome to participate (all animals must be either leashed or bridled)
- During the parade remember to keeping a pace of 1-3mph to keep the flow consistent as well as give spectators a good opportunity to view your entry; please maintain a close but safe distance from the entry in front and behind you
- Any participant standing or sitting on float or moving vehicle must remain there for the entirety of the event; those individuals getting on and off a moving vehicle will be asked to leave the parade route

## Parade Line-Up/Staging Information:

Parade participants may begin lining up at the Platte Valley Middle/Elementary School parking lot at 8:30am

Line-up/staging assignments and maps will be given to participants the week prior to the parade

Please park extra vehicles in the overflow parking at the stadium and middle school football field gravel parking lot

## Route Information:

Parade participants will enter west on Clark St. out of the PVS parking lot/bus line; continue west crossing Main St. (1st St.); following Civic Circle around Centennial park and back across Main St. (1st St.) east onto McIntyre St.; continue east on McIntyre St. passing Kohler Park (3rd St./McIntyre St.) to 5th St.; turn north on 5th St. an continue to Clark St.; turn east on Clark St. and enter parking lot/bus lane from the same area

\*Town of Kersey Police will be escorting parade participants and blocking road closures for the route

\*upon passing Centennial Park, drive at a slower pace as many people will be in the park watching

\*upon returning to the staging area, please clean up any mess left behind during preparations and set up

\*please check the map attached that indicates staging, parking and set up area
